

Facility Info



Camp Kiesel is a Cub Scout camp. Parking will be outside of the main gate.

Restrooms are located down near the tent camping area and up between the lodge and bunk rooms.

The camping area is in the lower field as you enter. Tent spaces will be marked off.

The lodge, bunk rooms, and firepit are uphill from the tent area. The lodge will serve as the main social space for many activities, hospitality and meals. There are 8 bunks per room. The bunks are built out of wood and will have a 2-inch foam mattress, but no bedding provided. The bunk rooms have wall heaters that can be turned on for chilly times. Showers are in the restrooms nearby between the bunks and the lodge.

Access to Causey Reservoir is outside of the camp. Head either just over the dam area, or a 1.5 mile drive to the public beach. We can NOT use the reservoir area attached to the camp.

Rules:

- No smoking inside the camp area
- No pets allowed
- No using the reservoir area attached to the camp
- No boating/swimming in pond
- No climbing structures

- No fires outside of the firepit
- No approaching wildlife (ESPECIALLY ANY MOOSE)
- Archery and BB Range Off Limits
- Clean up after yourself
